Thank you, as always, for your continued support. Let's make this final chapter of the year a great one full of joy, growth, and sunshine! - Mr. Reiter, Principal





Educational research indicates consistent attendance is an important factor in a student academic success.

In Saskatchewan, nearly 1 out of every 5 students do not graduate. In Chinook, that is 1 out of 7 students who do not graduate.
