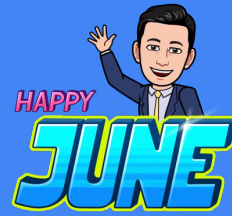

A fundraiser for one of our bravest stars.

This past August, one of our own, 7-year-old Norah, was diagnosed with B-cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (B-cell ALL).

Since then, Norah has been receiving ongoing outpatient treatment at the Jim Pattison Children's Hospital in Saskatoon. Her care involves intravenous chemotherapy, lumbar punctures, and oral chemotherapy. These treatments require regular trips between home and Saskatoon—a routine her family will continue for the next year and a half.

Despite the challenges, Norah is responding very well to treatment. Her resilience and positive spirit are truly inspiring. Norah is a bright, sweet, and funny student with a huge heart. She loves playing soccer, doing gymnastics, creating art, and camping with her family. Her strength and optimism continue to light up our school.

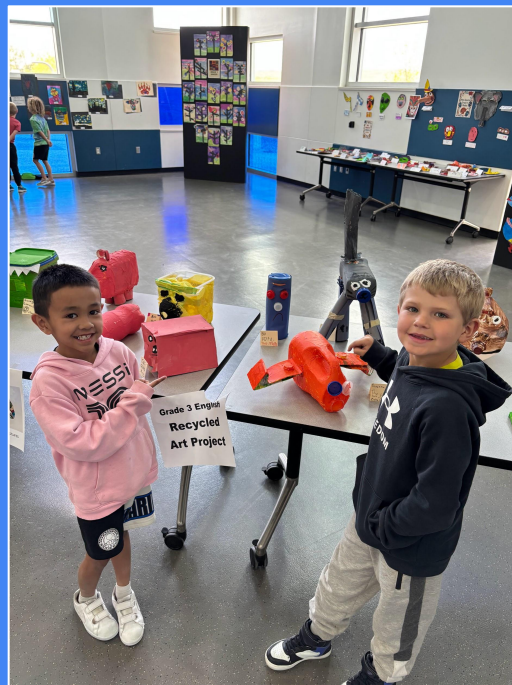
Ability Bowl
