


A MESSAGE FROM MR. REITER:

TRANSPORTATION REMINDERS:


August 27th is the cut off day for transportation (busing) change requests.

Report Cards will be printed and sent home on the last day of classes, June 26.


Report cards will also be posted online to MSS. You will receive an email notification when your student's report is posted to My School Sask on June 27.

On Friday, June 27th, you will receive your child's placement/supply list. Determining where students are placed is something we regard as highly important. A school team including administration, teachers and SST teachers has spent considerable time deciding where to place each student so that each child's learning experience will be most beneficial. Significant consideration and discussion is given to determining the best placement for each child based on several criteria.

We believe we have made decisions based on what is best for all students. Moving one student may have a domino effect on class lists so changes are extremely difficult once students are grouped. As always, our placements are tentative, if we have a significant increase in one grade level in the fall we may have to adjust our classroom enrolments.




